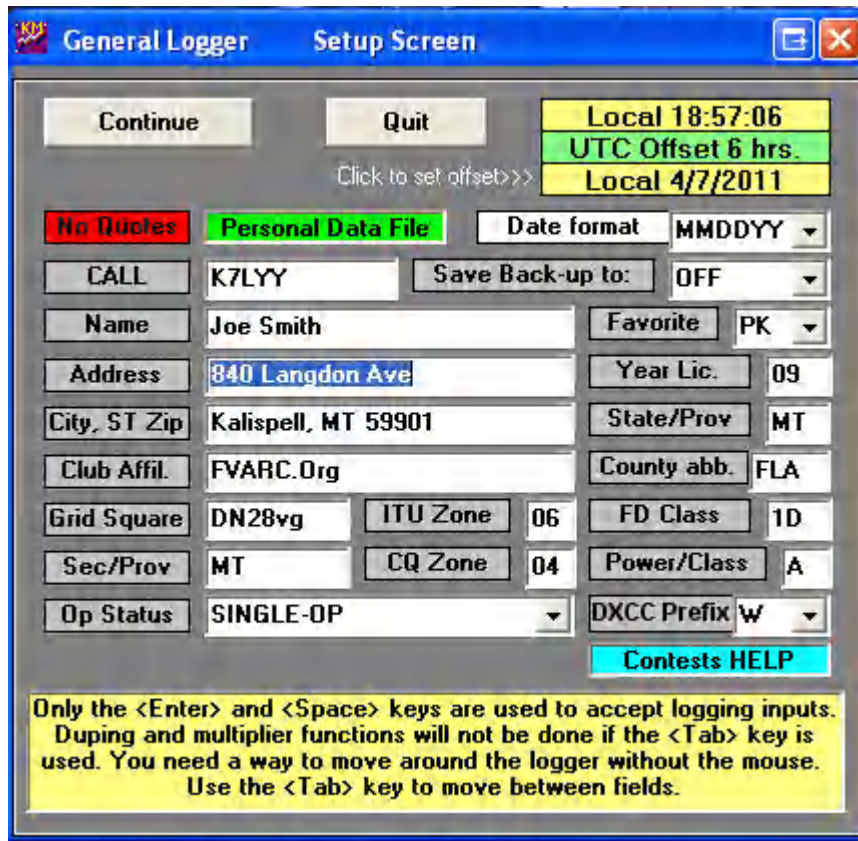


For those looking for a quick way to generate your log files for the MT QSO Party ----

- Download GenLog Logging program by Dave Mascaro W3KM:

- Install the program on your computer.
- Run the program – you will be presented with the initial setup screen:

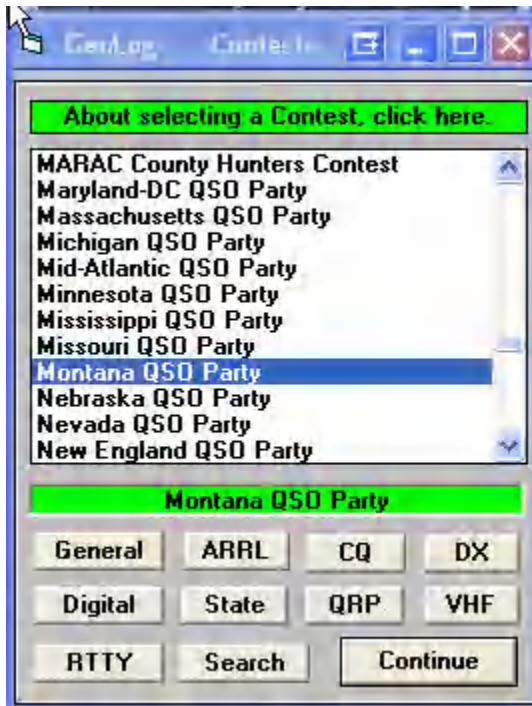

- Press Contest – select Montana QSO Party



- Select Multi/Bonus Button

Enter a Multiplier based on your Operating Power:

- 1 - > 150W - Low
- 2 - >5W < 150W - High
- 3 - < 5W – QRP

- If entering Scores in Real Time select "Real Time" otherwise select "After Contest"
- **When entering scores do not use the TAB button – only Space or Enter or it will not calculate Multipliers correctly**

- In the call Field Enter CallSign of Contact – press Space

- In Report – enter value QSO contact provided – press Space

- In Exch – enter value QSO Contact provided – Like State, Prov, etc – press Space

- The first time you press the "Save to Log" button it will ask for a log file to write to – give it a name and then save – if all looks well the screen will look something like the main screen above:

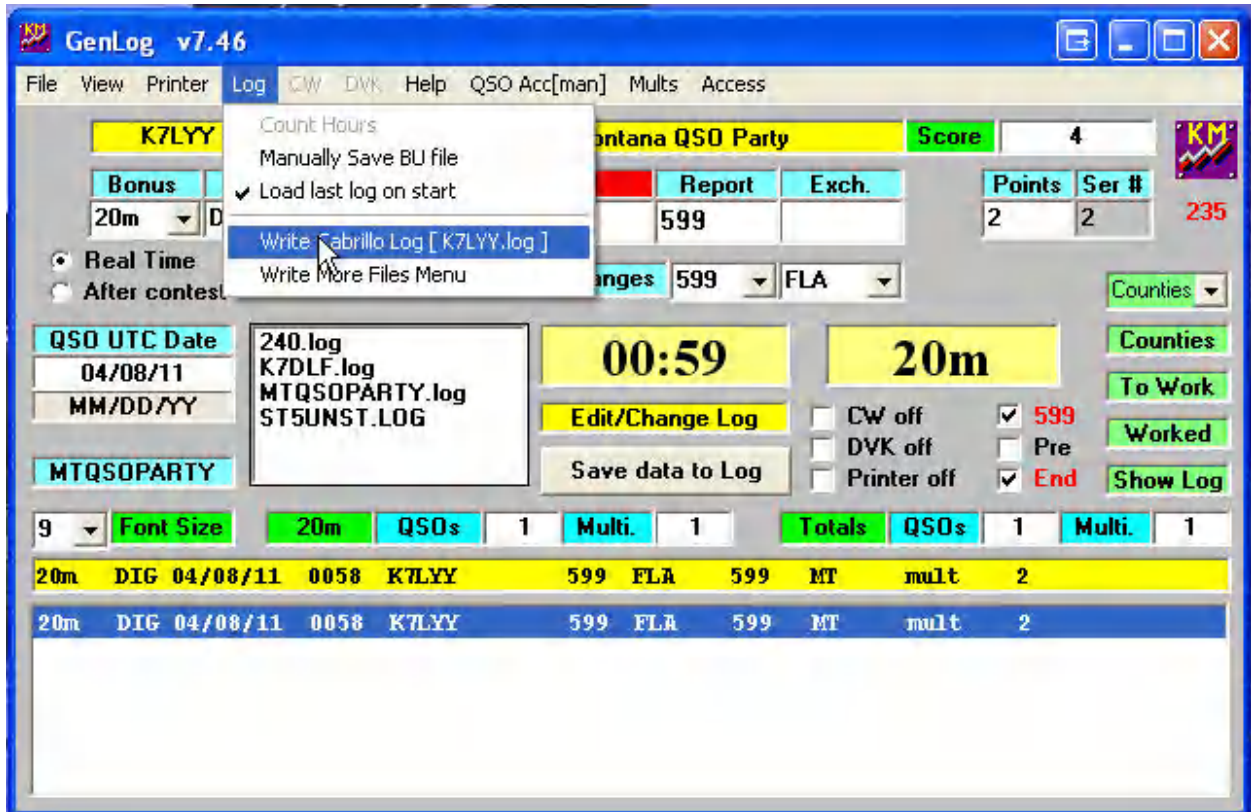
In my example I am running Digital Only, 20m band – logged one contact to K7LYY in MT. I have one QSO Total. Since I am running Low Power I have a Multi/Bonus value of 2. Since I am running

Digital each QSO is worth 2 points. I worked 1 state so far "MT" and got a Multiplier of 1 for it. My total score then is (1 Digital QSO worth 2 pts X 2 Power Multiplier X 1 State/Prov Multiplier = 4 pts).

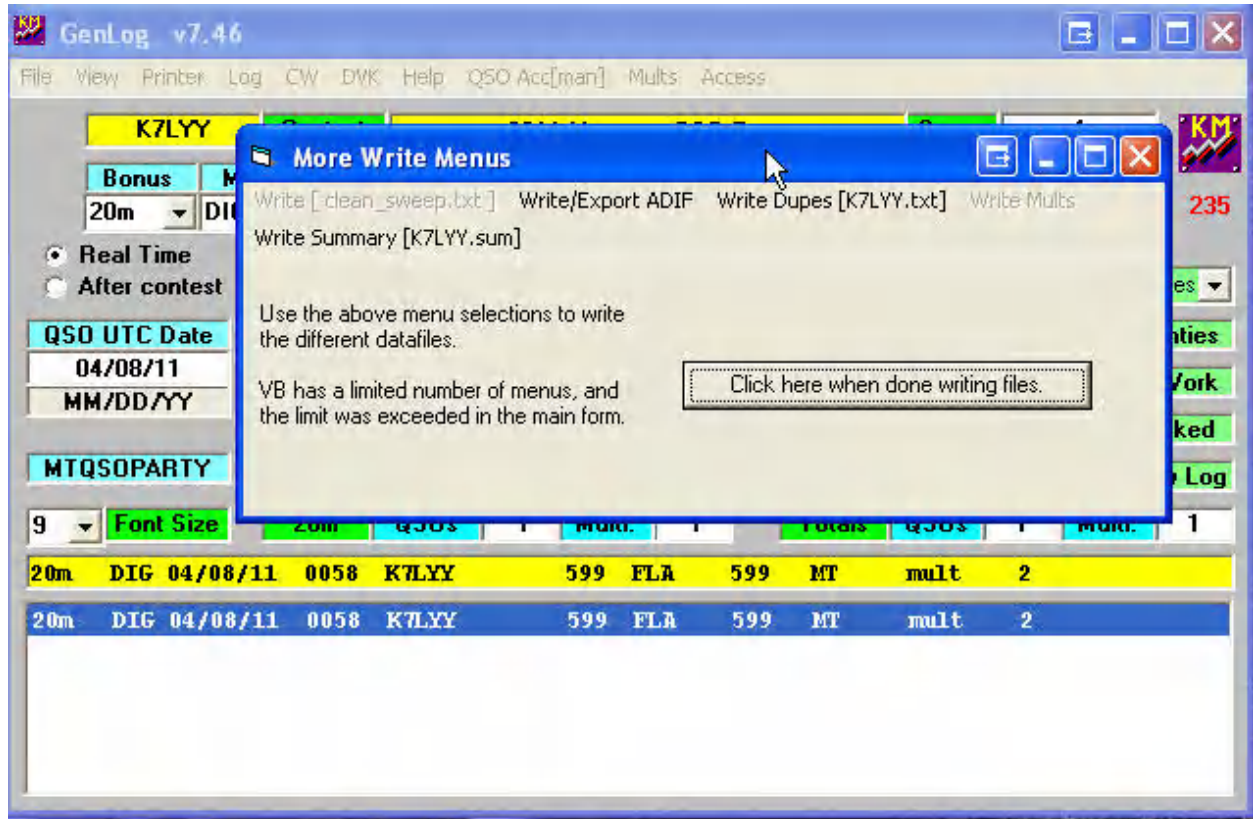
If everything is setup properly it should total the points for you.

- To generate Summary and Cabrillo files to send in after the contest:

Select Log/ Write Cabrillo Log – it will generate a log file of <callsign>.log in the GenLog directory



Select Log/ Write More Files Menu



Select Write Summary - it will generate a summary file of <callsign>.sum in the GenLog directory

- Email both files to the address in the QSO Party rules.
- Don't forget to fill in the Entry form on the Club site as well for auto tally and placement.
